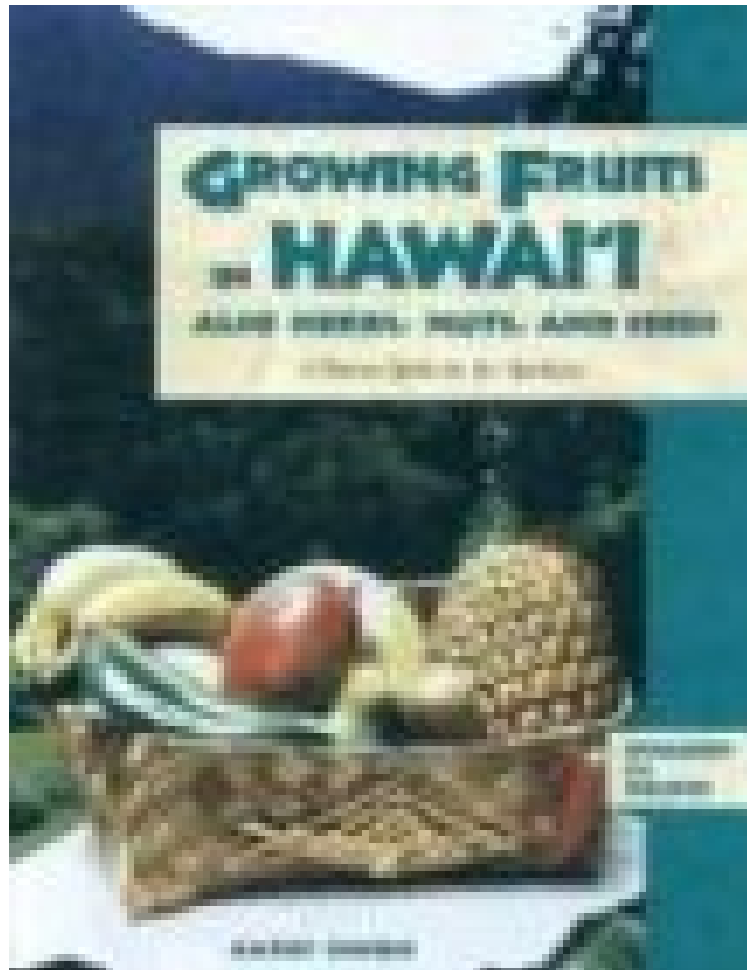


Growing Fruits in Hawaii Also Herbs, Nuts, and Seeds: A How-To Guide for the Gardener
