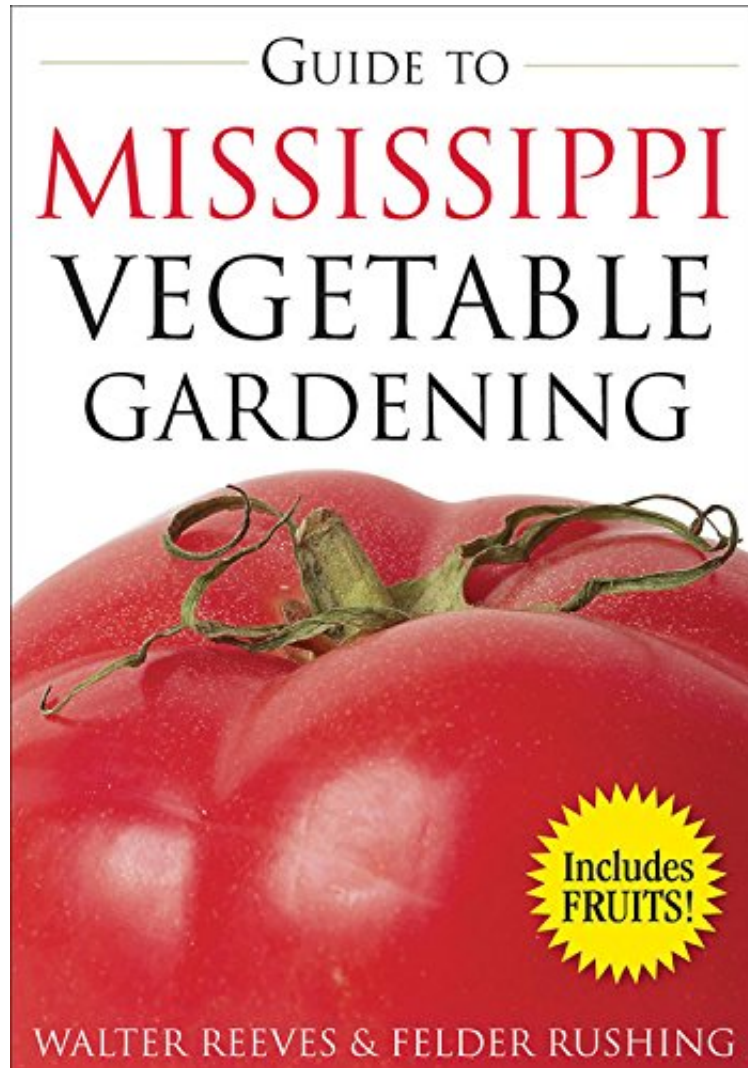

Service system. A section on pesticide uses. Beneficial insects, organic gardening and animal pest, including ants. A section on growing vegetables which talks about location, size, rows vs beds, container gardening. Then goes on to talk about soil preparation, composting, direct seeding, transplants, when to plant, how to plant, watering, mulching, fertilizing, weed and insect control. A section on herbs that includes planting, pest control, harvesting and drying. A section on fruits which talks about planting, pruning, caring for the plants/trees, pest control and thinning. A section on growing nuts. While other books cover the information provided, it is good to have a book that is specific to where you live. Some pests and diseases in other books may not apply to your area. More specific information is always better. This book also has a fairly easy to read font.

This book offers advice on everything from starting your garden from seed, to planning your garden with helpful space saving techniques. Make this guide a must-have resource for anyone interested in growing vegetables, no matter what their space requirements. Helpful charts will outline when to plant and when to harvest cool and warm season vegetables.
