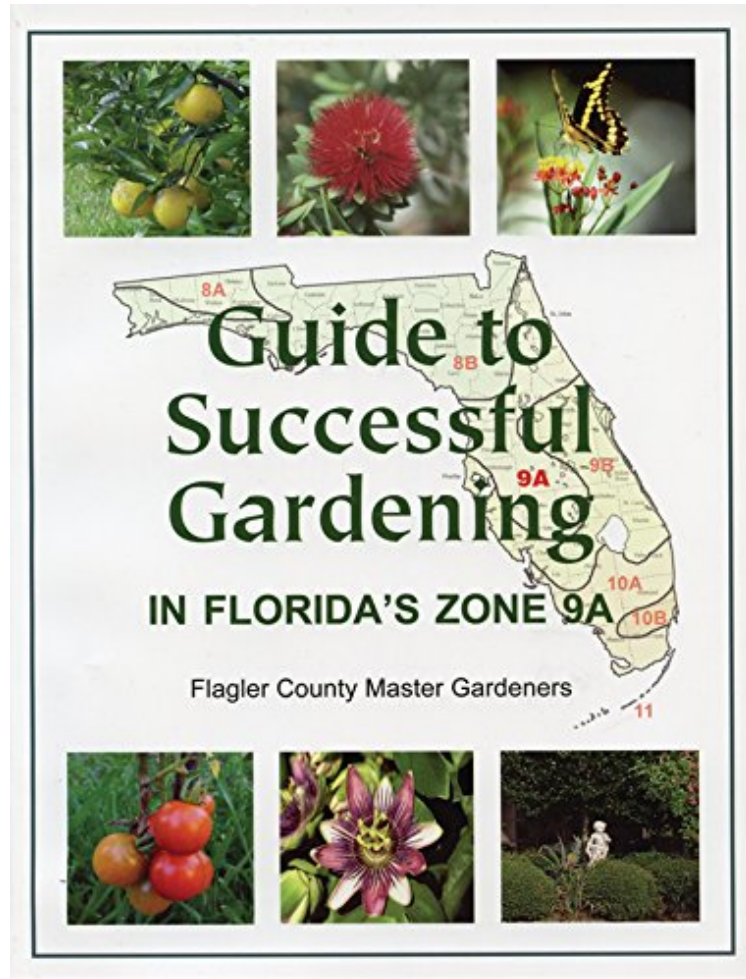

You can "grow anything" in Florida, but only things that don't need the cold to thrive. That means, of course, that you can plant things that need heat or a very mild winter. Here in the northern part of Florida, we have occasional frosts/hard freezes, so you need a plant that can take that every now and then without dying, but that doesn't need it in order to live. In addition, part of my city is Zone 9B, meaning that even though I don't live near the beaches I'm considered to have a more coastal climate. As an extremely beginner gardener I felt overwhelmed.I was so glad to find this book! It gives great advice and tips, as well as very good charts with times to plant in this area. It talks about the problems with certain plants as

well.
