For example, there's a very interesting section on African modernism. The chapters give a lot of architectural and artistic context, so you can see the overall setting in which the furniture would have been used. There are very nice color photographs throughout. My only complaint, which is minor, is that the photo used opposite the first page of each chapter isn't identified, which can be frustrating. I'm not an
