I like pink, and I would say that the paint color on my first floor is a very muted pink (emphasis on muted), it isn't a color I would gravitate to when decorating. The paint color we have is one of those where I would initially say - it isn't pink, it isn't peach, it isn't tan - but when I really look at it, I keep coming back to "it is pink" but with a lot of gray and brown to soften it and make it more gender-neutral. I can't say that I have pink anywhere else in my house. Anyway, back to the book. The book is in three sections, each with an increased use of pink: That Touch of Pink (54 pages), More Pink (58 pages), and A Profusion of Pink (51 pages). The first section uses pink mostly as an accent - pillows, a chair or two, floral arrangements, etc. The examples of pink wall colors in this section are very soft and light. In the second section, More Pink, pink takes a little more prominent role, with some larger items (or more items) in pink. The wall colors given as examples have a little more intensity. The final section, A Profusion of Pink, pink is taking more of a starring role in most of the rooms, however there are very few "all pink" rooms. The wall colors used in the sample section are deep

and rich. If you like the color pink and how it can be mixed with other colors to create a beautiful (and more gender generic) space, then this book might be for you.
